The School Enterprise Challenge

Our award-winning flagship programme, the <u>School Enterprise Challenge</u>, is a proven educational programme that guides teachers step-by-step in facilitating student teams through the process of business ideation, planning and setting up of a real school business. It is suitable for all schools (primary and secondary) from all countries and is available in English and Spanish. The programme provides high quality resources, guidance and support to schools and partners to build teachers' capacity, helping them to adopt project-based learning and experiential education approaches to improve students' learning outcomes and their skills. We also have a ready-made structure for assessment, feedback, recognition and rewards for schools, with cash-prizes for the most enterprising business teams, students and teachers.

Our programme has already made a significant impact. Since 2011, we have reached more than 40,000 schools, trained 20,000 teachers in practical entrepreneurship education and experiential learning techniques and empowered more than 500,000 young learners with key life and business skills. Schools have established a diverse range of sustainable businesses from plant nurseries, handicrafts, chicken farms, and student banks, and raised over \$3.5 million USD for school communities.

Joint Commitment

We put a huge amount of effort into supporting partners to successfully adopt and adapt the School Enterprise Challenge to fit with their organisation's needs and the local context. To ensure the quality delivery and sustainability of the program, we include a comprehensive training component as part of partnership, which recognizes the importance of equipping your team with the necessary skills and knowledge. For sustainability, partners are asked in turn to make a commitment to cover the costs of providing the required training and support. The cost of this is normally US\$1,500 per person, with partners required to include a minimum of 2 members of staff in the training program.
